## Pastor's Corner

Dear friends in Christ,

November is traditionally a season of thanks giving, and there has been so much to be thankful for at Grace – and you are one of those gifts! My heart is full as I reflect on the many ways I've seen members and friends of Grace share their gifts, lend a hand with projects, and offered their time to support the missions and ministries. Thanks be to God!

As November draws to a close, we shift our hearts to the season of Advent – the four weeks of preparation leading up to Christmas. Flyers with all the details for worship opportunities are available in the narthex. They are both a meaningful reminder of the importance of gathering together, as well as a gentle invitation to others to experience the hope, peace, joy, and love of Christ.

Deep down we want people in our lives to know they are special and that we love them. Advent can be filled with worry about finding the perfect Christmas gifts. But sometimes we overlook the greatest gift of all... our very presence. Our spiritual ancestors were also worried — often about survival in the midst of political occupation. And the response of the scriptures is "the Holy Living One is with you." Like a shepherd who never leaves the flock, we are held close. This advent season, we are invited to be the gift of presence for our loved ones, for our communities, for those who need it most.

The theme for our advent and Christmas this year stems from Dr. Marcia McFee, "The Gift of Being Present." I invite you to be present with us as each week as we explore how early Christians were present with hope, peace, joy, love, and light…and how we can be present in the 21<sup>st</sup> century too.

As a way to remember our loved ones at Christmas, we offer a memorial tree again this year. In the sanctuary will be a special tree dedicated to remembering our loves ones who are no longer with us. Beside the tree are paper ornaments where you are invited to write the names of your loved ones. Simply place on the tree as a visual reminder as we remember who there were to us.

May this Advent season remind us to present in all ways and in all seasons of life. There are many opportunities to be present together as people of faith (in person or online), to gather together as an example for those who need to know Jesus' love and share that love with all we meet!   we are not alone. The service includes scripture readings, candlelight, and songs to offer us hope in the
  midst of the darkness. Service will not be livestreamed. All are welcome.

- December 14 Worship at 10 a.m. Grace Senior Choir will be offering songs of the season.
   Third Sunday of Advent Joy. All are welcome.
- December 14 Beginning at 1 p.m., Grace is hosting a community Christmas caroling. Event to include special music, musicians, and singers for your listening pleasure, as well as scriptures, and plenty of Christmas caroling to singulong and put you in the spirit. All are welcome.
- December 21 9 a.m. Sunday School, Intergenerational Worship at 10 a.m. to include the Christmas program. Fourth Sunday of Advent – Love. Christmas Fund special offering will be taken. See newsletter for more details.
- December 24 Christmas Eve Worship at 4:30 p.m. will include the sacrament of Holy Communion all are welcome at the table! Grace Senior Choir will be singing. The story of Jesus' birth, Christmas carols, and candlelight will help us celebrate the gift of Jesus' birth as we give the gift of being present.


# Please Support the Christmas Fund Special Offering on 12/21


